The Gravel Doctor

The Gravel Doctor was established in 1997 in this area, and in 2001 expanded their service area into Eastern Ontario. The company employs just fewer than 20 full time employees; this increases in the winter months to 30 including sub contractors.

The Gravel Doctor utilizes a unique system to remove potholes, ruts and corrugations. The system recycles existing gravel to save on the purchasing of new materials, and creates a "scarified" re-graded surface that is compacted with a 3,000 pound roller. The company states that their mission is to:

- Recover and recycle the useable gravel in your existing driveway;
- Cut out and remove each pothole and rut;
- · Prepare the surface, ready to accept new gravel; and
- Eliminate layering a layer of new gravel spread on top of an inconsistent surface is inherently unstable and will lead to early failure of the driveway surface.

In 2008, The Gravel Doctor expanded their services, offering asphalt paving, stone masonry and stone facing, concrete sidewalks and curbing, property maintenance and grass cutting, as well as interlock driveways, decks, fences, windows and doors. In addition the business now has tri-axle dump trucks and offer equipment sales, servicing and rentals. The newest addition is Acrylic Stucco and Home Transformations, and offer free estimates. The Gravel Doctor is your down to earth outdoor contractor.

The Gravel Doctor is a member of the Landscape Ontario Horticultural Trades Association, the Better Business Bureau and the Chamber of Commerce.
