Summer Jobs Service Here for students and employers!

For many local students, now is the time to think about summer employment! And for local businesses, funds are available to help with hiring of summer student staff.

The Employment and Education Centre (EEC) in Brockville is once again offering the Summer Jobs Service (SJS). This Employment Ontario-funded program helps local young people between 15 and 30 have a summer job while giving employers a subsidy to help with the cost of taking on additional staff.

The SJS kicked off at the beginning of April and it runs until the end of September. Bill Bannan, who helps to co-ordinate the program, notes 343 placements were subsidized locally last year, and the agency can subsidize even more for 2011. The subsidy amount is \$2 per hour per placement; the program is open to students and businesses throughout Leeds and Grenville.

Bannan notes that 2011 is the first time that EEC is the primary delivery agency of this service throughout the United Counties. "For some employers, the Summer Jobs Service means the difference between employing a couple of students versus none at all," Bannan stated. He added EEC through summer jobs service also advertises summer jobs on its job board and pre-screens resumes for employers. "An employer could say they are looking for a particular skill set, and we would send them candidates based on the criteria they give," Bannan explained.
